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Instructor Declaration

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RAANZ holds a Part 149 Recreational Organisation Certificate issued by the Director of Civil Aviation allowing us to issue licenses on his behalf.

This is similar to the way that we have worked with Part 103 delegation except that there is more emphasis on quality control, problem feedback procedures and ongoing education.

Our systems in the past have worked well, with few exceptions, but it is timely to reinforce some of the responsibilities of Instructors.

Instructors have always been, and will always be, key people in microlighting.

They often are the first point of contact with a prospective pilot and they are responsible for passing on good pilot habits that the new pilot will have for their flying career.

They also have a less obvious responsibility to act as part of the RAANZ team, to support the organisation in a positive and constructive manner, and to fully understand and comply with RAANZ Operations and Procedures.

Each new instructor will be asked to sign this form as part of achieving their instructor rating. RAANZ will hold these on file.
